

# DEVA CURL INSTRUCTION

## Pre-Wash:

This step is for those first starting to use the Deva Curl products. Before you get your hair wet apply the Deva No-Poo to the length of your your hair. Your hair will instantly feel moisturized. Rinse the No-Poo and continue with steps 1-6.

## STEP 1:

Wet hair and massage Deva No-Poo into scalp. There won't be any lather but this shampoo cleanses you hair of all the product you've used without leaving any of its own soapy residue. Repeat if necessary.

## Step 2:

Using Deva Condition One work through the ends of the hair, combing out knots with fingers. Rinse thoroughly. For extra dry or damaged hair repeat conditioning step up to three times, concentrating mainly in the length and ends of the hair. Not so much on the scalp. This conditioner can also be used as a leave in when applied sparingly the third time.

## Step 3:

While still in the shower tip head up-side-down. Shake head slowly from side to side to release the curls naturally. You may also, gently use your fingers to comb through and separate your hair more. This will also allow for some of the excess water to drain off.

## Step 4:

With the Deva BeLeavin, run hands over the hair softly to coat your hair. Then using a liberal amount of Deva AnGell, or the new Arch AnGell, gently scrunch hair until saturated with the product. To dry hair so its not dripping wet, use paper towels or a cotton, no-lint, t-shirt and continue gently scrunching hair. Be careful not to disturb the way the curls have naturally fallen. NEVER USE A TERRY CLOTH TOWEL TO DRY HAIR!! SCRUNCHING ONLY!!

## Step 5:

To get some extra lift simply place flat two pronged clips in the areas where you want the lift. Do this carefully as to not disturb the curl groupings. For best results allow hair to air dry with the clips. You may also use a defuser but be careful again, not to disturb the curl groupings.

## Step 6:

When hair is completely dry turn head upside down. Starting from the roots gently shake curls loose using your fingers and re-scrunch the ends. At this point you do not want to pull or comb the hair. If there is any frizz use Deva Set-it-Free, Mist-er Right, or Set-Me-Up. With a little bit in your hands lightly run hands over the frizzy areas or try scrunching if the curls aren't as tight as you would like.

## Day 2:

Your curls should stay intact for the next couple of days. To refresh them you can use any of the Deva styling products, Set-it-Free, Mist-er Right, or Set-Me-Up. Just scrunch the product into you hair, trying not to disturb the natural curl patterns.
